

**2010 Crisco® Junior Chefs National Pie Championships (“NPC”)
 (“Contest”)
 OFFICIAL RULES**

TO ENTER: Complete the entry form and mail it along with the recipe and applicable entry fee to American Pie Council, P.O. Box 368, Lake Forest, IL 60045. Recipe must be provided in English on a typed 8 1/2 x 11 paper or compact disk and must include the name of entrant. Recipes and entry forms may also be emailed to apc@piecouncil.org or faxed to 847-371-0199. Recipes and entry forms must be postmarked no later than April 9, 2010. **LIMIT: A maximum of one entry per person.** All entries including the recipe submitted become the property of the American Pie Council (“APC”) and The J.M. Smucker Company (“Sponsors”) and none will be returned.

CATEGORIES: Apple, Fruit/Berry, Cream, and Open. Only dessert pies may be entered and must include a bottom and side crust. All Contest recipes must include at least 1/2 cup of **Crisco** shortening or oil. Recipes using alcohol as an ingredient will not be accepted.

JUDGING: All entrants must prepare and bake their pies at the Omni Championsgate, Championsgate, FL during their assigned times on Saturday, April 24, 2010. Potential winners (subject to eligibility verification) will be chosen on or about April 25, 2010 by APC judges whose decisions will be final on all matters relating to this Contest. Each pie entry will be judged on the following criteria: *First Impression:* Pre slice score (Includes consistency of crust or topping) and after slice score (based on degree of appropriate runniness, juiciness or firmness) and impression of first taste. *A Closer Look:* Flavor (strength and balance of flavor appropriate for type of pie; balance of sweet and/or tartness. Peripheral flavors should be balanced with main ingredient of pie), Mouth Feel (appropriate consistency, i.e. thick, thin, smooth, creamy, chalky, mushy, runny, dry, sticky, etc.), Crust (flaky or mealy) and Aftertaste (pleasant or unpleasant). *Creativity:* (originality). *Overall Appeal:* (impressiveness). The judging criteria will be based on a 0-9 point system for each of the above categories. All category points will be added to determine the winners. In the event of a tie the judges will re-judge the pies until a winner is decided.. For safety reasons, all refrigerated pies will be tested to assure that the temperature does not exceed 45°. Each recipe must include U.S. standard measurements, complete preparation instructions, cooking time and temperatures, number of servings, size of pans and any special utensils or cookware.

ELIGIBILITY: This Contest is open to legal residents of the 50 United States and D.C. aged 14 to 17 on April 24, 2010, except employees of the Sponsors (and, with respect to their designated pie category, each participating food company),, their affiliated companies, parent, subsidiaries, Web site developers and administrators, and advertising and promotion agencies and their immediate families and members of their households. All entrants must have a parent or legal guardian present and sign a waiver. All entrants must bring all required ingredients to prepare and bake their pies on Saturday, April 24, 2010. All standard utensils and an oven will be provided. The Contest recipe must be an original that was created by the person making the entry. The Contest recipe entered

must not have won previous awards, must not infringe upon any other person's rights, must not have been previously published, must not be awaiting publication nor may it be submitted for publication consideration during the period of the Contest.

PRIZES: One Grand Prize: One \$2000 Scholarship (awarded as a check) and a large **Crisco** gift basket. Approximate Retail Value ("ARV") \$2075. Four First Place Prizes: One \$100 gift certificate for Emile Henry USA, one \$100 gift certificate for Cuisipro USA and a **Crisco** gift basket. Total ARV of each First Prize: \$240. Total ARV of all Prizes: \$3035.

In case of cancellation, a winning recipe will be chosen from all eligible entries received prior to the date of cancellation and if circumstances permit. If due to any technical, production, typographical or other error, more prizes are claimed or awarded than are described in the Official Rules at any prize level, the number of prizes identified in the Official Rules will be awarded in an equitable manner (as determined by Sponsors) from all such prize claims received. By participating, entrants agree that all issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Official Rules, entrant's rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of the Sponsors in connection with the Contest, will be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of State of Ohio, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules.
